## **FLASH: Clandestine Rendition of Ivory Billed Woodpecker Exposed**

The Editor-in-Chief and staff of Dogs Daily Wear have always respected national security concerns. At times, DDW has agreed to withhold compromising information or literary bribes.

However, the information on a failed rendition attempt by the National Security Agency (NSA), CIA and the Pentagon does not now, in DDW's opinion, damage the security at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, and therefore, we believe the public should be informed.<sup>1</sup>
